### I. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

1. **(ID # 12431) Act – Amendment-UCC Consolidated Plan:**

AN ACT to authorize the County to submit an Urban County Application under the Federal Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grants and HOME programs, including an amendment to FY 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan and to accept such Grants.

Assistant Commissioner Zaino from the Planning Department came before the committees to discuss item #12431- Act- Amendment - UCC Consolidated plan. This is an Act that would authorize filing of the application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for approximately \$4,600,000 from three sources; Community Block

Development Grant (CBDG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnership Program. It will also authorize the County to submit to HUD and amendment to the FY 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan including an Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2020. The Plan has been developed in consultation with members of the County Planning Board, Westchester Urban County Council and the Community Development Advisory Group. It has been subject to public comment on a local level before applications have been submitted. The Federal award would be approximately \$3,600,000 from CBDG, \$850,000 from HOME and \$150,000 from ESG. The Consortium consist of 27 Communities right now, about 360,000 residents. The highest eligible community is the Village of Port Chester. Once the application is submitted HUD has 45 days to respond. With a motion by Legislator Parker and seconded by Legislator Johnson the item was approved with a vote of 9-0.
